Beardstown, IL Havana, IL
Florence, IL Meredosia, IL

Producers must follow the Century Corn identity preservation protocol from planting through delivery to assure complete Non-GMO purity and comply with end-user requirements. These requirements also include:

- Delivery of #2YC, 15.0% Moisture.
- Proper equipment cleaning and production management.
- Border row management.
- No insecticide or fungicide applied after plant emergence through delivery.
- Maintaining accurate production and handling records.
- At Cargill's request, attend a Century Corn training meeting before planting.
- Submit bin sample post harvest.
- Always follow label instructions for all crop protection chemicals.
- Submit field map and production data.
- Planting on prior year GMO fields prohibited.

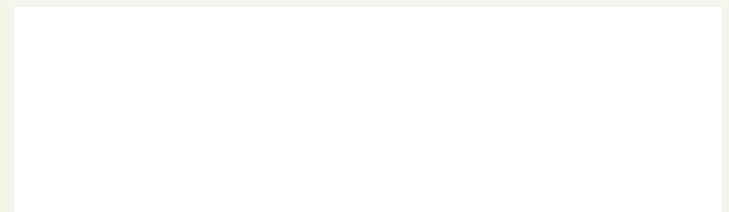
