Producers must follow an identity preservation protocol from planting through delivery to comply with end-user requirements. These requirements include:

- Delivery of #1YC, 15.0% moisture.
- Maintain kernel temperatures below 130°F when drying artificially.
- 20% or less stress cracks.
- Maintain accurate production and handling records.
- At Cargill's request, attend a Food Grade Corn training meeting.
- Submit bin sample post harvest.
- Follow label instructions for all crop protection chemicals.

Increased 2007 Premiums

The Premiums for Food Grade Corn have increased for 2007, ranging from \$0.12 - \$0.15 per bushel for early signup. Availability is limited and subject to change.
