Program Overview

The 2007 Premium Maize Program is available to producers delivering to most Cargill Service Centers located on the Illinois River, East St. Louis, Southern Indiana, and Greater Cincinnati.

Producers must follow a Non-GMO identity preservation protocol from planting through delivery to comply with program requirements. These requirements include:

- Delivery of #2YC, 15.0% moisture.
- Proper equipment cleaning and production management.
- Border row management.
- No insecticide or fungicide applied after plant emergence through delivery.
- Dryer Temperature below 125°F during artificial drying.
- Maintain accurate production and handling records.
- At Cargill's request, attend a Cargill sponsored training meeting.
- Submit bin sample post harvest.
- Comply with Cargill's chemical residue protocol and follow label instructions for crop protection chemicals.
- Planting on prior year GMO fields prohibited.

2007 Premiums

The per bushel incentives for Premium Maize have increased for 2007 and range from \$0.25 - \$0.30 per bushel for early signup. Program availability is limited and subject to change. 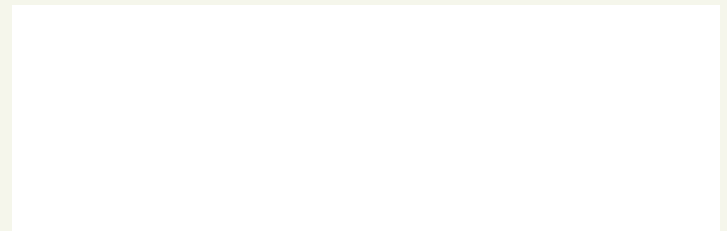
