

CARGILL BLAIR CORN RECEIVING TEMPORARY DETOUR **STARTING 10/08/25:**

The city of Blair will be installing a replacement water line starting Wednesday, October 8th. During this time, no inbound traffic from Hwy 30 to the Cargill facility will be allowed. There will only be one lane on Industrial Park Drive, which will be utilized for outbound traffic only. All inbound corn truck traffic must turn at 1st street by the PetroMart and then take a left on Grant St. and follow signs to corn staging area. Corn truck flow through the plant and truck exiting is as normal on Industrial Park Drive to Hwy 30. This detour is estimated to be in use for several weeks. Maps will be handed out at the scale house window as you check in.

-  **No truck entry** on Industrial drive from Hwy 30
- **Only northbound traffic** will be allowed through the remaining lane on Industrial Park Drive.
- **Corn truck traffic** will be rerouted via a **temporary path from Grant St. to Corn Road**.
- Once on Corn Road, **normal plant flow resumes** and trucks will still **exit north on Industrial Park Drive**.
- If staging lanes are full, loaded trucks will be directed as normal to the outbound lanes.
- Please **be aware** of extra security and personnel presence helping with traffic flow.
